## Meeting of the ICDLI Technical Committee

During the Technical Committee's Meeting in Frankfurt, Germany, from the 5<sup>th</sup> until the 6<sup>th</sup> of November 2013, three new technical leaflets has been revised, updated and published: on Bonding and Processing of HPL on mineral substrates, on Bonding and Processing of metal substrates and a guideline for CE marking. Furthermore, Mrs Sabine Dröge, a lawyer of Polycomply Hoechst GmbH, informed about REACH Enforcement and the consequences for Downstream Users, the update of the Candidate and Authorization List and also about the legislation in China, Turkey, Russia and Switzerland which is similar to REACH.
