## Manufacturer Meeting in St. Petersburg

The Manufacturer Meeting 2018 took place on the invitation of ICDLI member Slotex in the Russian cultural metropolis St. Petersburg. The current development of the HPL industry in Europe was the focus of the discussions. In an intensive exchange, the members reported on their expectations and experiences in the market. The report covered the latest industry data, the activities of the ICDLI in marketing and PR as well as the work of the Technical Commission. The industry meeting was rounded off with a factory tour of Slotex.



## Technical Committee

Under the chair of Dr. Lutz Reitzel, Re-sopal GmbH, the Technical Commission of the ICDLI met at the Institut für Holztechnologie (IHD) in Dresden. In addition to the main topics of standardization, environment and the processing of technical leaflets, formaldehyde, VOC and CARB were also on the agenda. IDH experts provided information on volatile organic compound (VOC) measurement methods, the requirements of the California Air Resources Board (CARB) and the

resulting requirements for European manufacturers of HPL.



The new Environmental Product Declarations (EPDs) issued at the end of last year have met with a first positive response. The new EPDs are listed both on the website of the Institut für Bauen und Umwelt, the database Ökobaudat of the German Federal Ministry of Building. Both websites are used in particular by architects and planners. The topic of knowledge transfer was newly included in the work program of the Technical Commission. Ideas for a new training and further education concept are currently being developed.
